- Yourself, and a spirit of celebration!

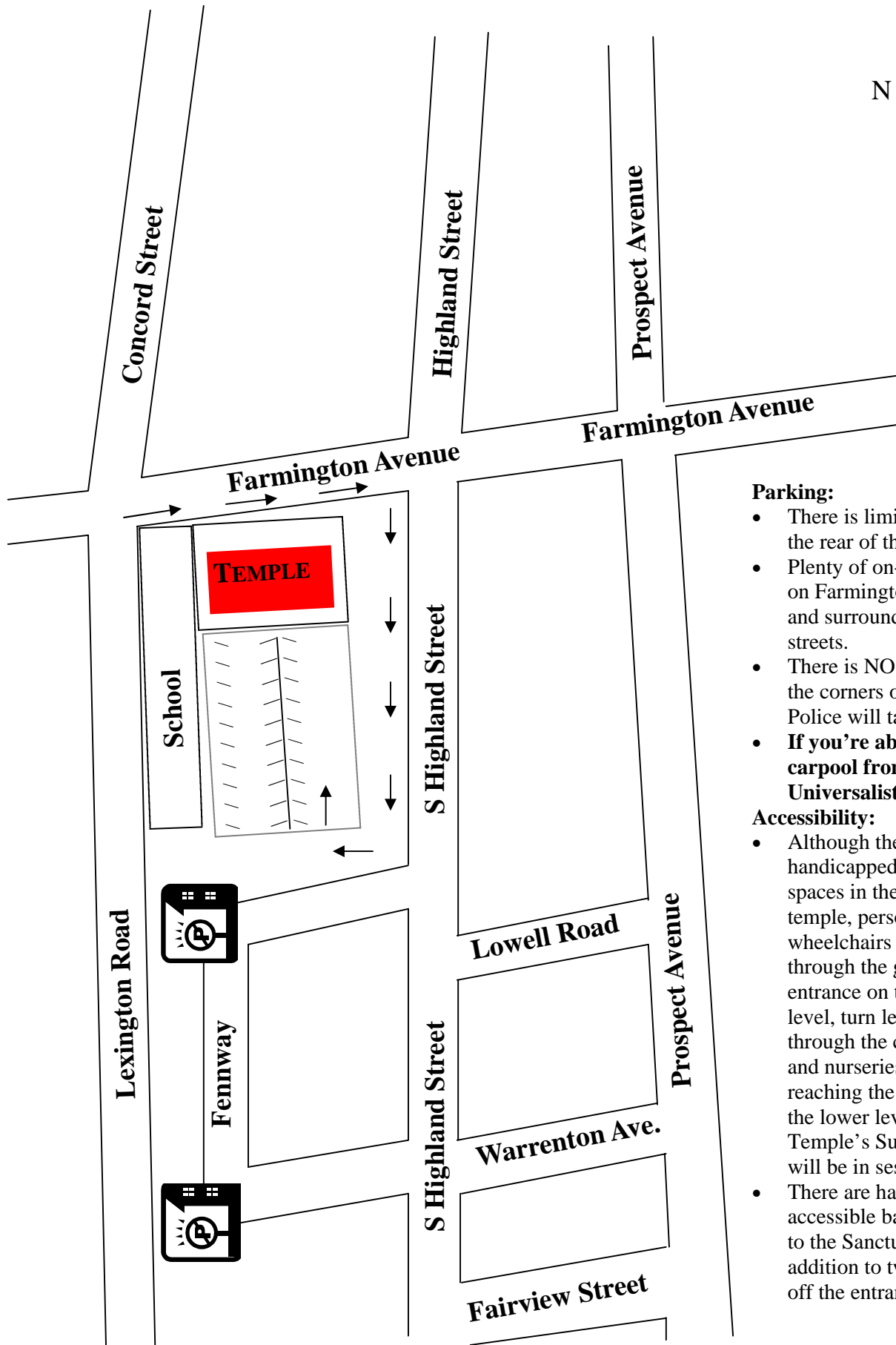
Dear Friends,

Parking:

- There is limited parking in the rear of the temple.

Accessibility:
